WRWA TO HOST **TSA Pre✓** ENROLLMENT CENTER

OKLAHOMA CITY, August 4, 2016 – Oklahoma residents will be able to apply for the Transportation Security Administration’s [TSA Pre✓](#)® program at the Will Rogers World Airport (WRWA) terminal beginning Monday, August 22 through Friday, September 3. The airport, in partnership with TSA, is hosting a temporary enrollment center to facilitate participation in the agency’s popular expedited screening program.

The [TSA Pre✓](#)® program allows participating flyers to experience a more efficient airport screening process by leaving on their shoes, light jackets and belts and leaving laptops and compliant liquids in carry-on bags. Over 180 airports have dedicated [TSA Pre✓](#)® lanes and 16 airlines participate in the program including.

The enrollment center will be located pre-security in the middle of the ticket lobby between the American and Southwest ticket counters, and will not require the applicant to be a ticketed passenger. *The center will be open Monday, through Wednesday from 10:00am to 7:00pm and Thursday through Friday from 7:00am to 4pm.* The center will be closed Saturday and Sunday.

The TSA Pre✓® application process allows U.S. citizens and lawful permanent residents to enroll online at tsa.gov. Once the required information has been completed, the enrollee can then schedule an appointment at the WRWA temporary enrollment center at which they will provide fingerprints, payment and valid identity and citizenship/immigration documentation. The application fee is \$85 and can be paid by credit card, money order, company check, or certified/cashier's check. Cash and personal checks are not accepted. The application fee is valid for five (5) years. The center will accept walk-ups, but pre-enrollment on line is encouraged.

When applying online, applicants should type in the location “Oklahoma City, OK,” then choose “Oklahoma City, OK – Will Rogers World Airport.” When the applicant clicks “Next” at the bottom of the screen, they will be able to select a preferred appointment time.

Once the enrollment is complete, successful applicants will receive a Known Traveler Number (KTN) within a few weeks. The enrollee then enters that number when booking an airline reservation. The KTN can also be added when booking reservations online via a participating airline website, via phone call to the airline reservation center, or with the travel management company making reservations. Additionally, the KTN can be entered in participating airline frequent flyer profiles, where it will be stored for future reservations.

Will Rogers World Airport is the city’s commercial airport and accommodates over 3.8 million travelers each year. The airport serves 22 nonstop airports with an average of 69 daily departures.
